# Frequently Asked Questions

## What are the required child restraints for children aged under 4 years?

Children aged from 0 months and less than approximately 4 years are allowed to travel in our vehicles only if they travel in an approved baby seat that is appropriate for their size and weight. The baby seat must be fitted in the rear of the vehicle in a rear-facing seat only, if the child weighs 0-10kg. Children weighing up to 18kg must travel in the rear of the vehicle in a forward facing seat only.

#### What child restraints are applicable for children over the age of 4 years old?

Children aged over the age of approximately 4 and less than 150cm tall or younger than approximately 12 years old are allowed to travel in our vehicles only if they travel in an approved booster seat appropriate for their size and weight.

### Who is responsible to fit the seats in the vehicle?

It is the customer's responsibility to fit the Child Restraints in the vehicle. Guests can either bring their own baby or booster seats, or rent seats from Apollo (subject to availability). Please note that Apollo's vehicles are not equipped to handle Isofix seats. Standard 3-point seatbelts only.
